PROCEDURAL ORDER

9 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

10 The hearing in Phase II of this proceeding concluded on July 31, 2001. On August 3, 2001, a
11 Stipulation Concerning Testimony Related to Switching Issues was filed by Qwest Corporation,
12 AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc. ("AT&T"), WorldCom, Inc., XO Arizona, Inc.,
13 Cox Arizona Telecom, Inc., Sprint Communications Company, and Staff. This Stipulation provides
14 that certain previously filed testimony should be disregarded in this phase of the case and considered
15 in a later hearing in this matter.

16 The stipulating parties also recommended that the following schedule be established for
17 consideration of switching issues: Qwest to file additional cost studies on August 31, 2001; CLECs
18 and Staff to file rebuttal on September 24, 2001; and Qwest to file surrebuttal on October 16, 2001.

19 By Procedural Order issued on August 7, 2001, the procedural stipulation for consideration of
20 switching issues was adopted, and a hearing date of November 7, 2001 was established.

21 On September 24, 2001, AT&T filed an Unopposed Request for Amendment of the
22 Procedural Order. AT&T represents that the parties have agreed that the date for filing rebuttal
23 testimony should be extended to September 27, 2001 and the date for filing surrebuttal testimony
24 should be extended to October 19, 2001.

25 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the CLECs and Staff shall file rebuttal testimony by
26 September 27, 2001.


