RE: LETTER OF CONCERN in the matter of the application of The Solar Alliance for approval of an Adjudication of "Not a Public Service Corporation" Status.

DOCKET No. E-20633A-08-0513

Ironco Enterprises, LLC. (Ironco) wishes to express its concern regarding obtaining a rapid decision regarding The Solar Alliance application.

Ironco is a veteran-owned small business working in the structural and miscellaneous steel and renewable energy construction markets. It is located within the City of Phoenix Enterprise Zone. The company was formed in 1999 and at its peak in 2008 employed over 100 ironworkers, tradesman, engineers and office staff. Employment during this recession is down 60%.

Ironco is a sub-contractor on two solar construction projects at both Arizona State University (ASU) and University of Arizona (U of A). The total value of these projects exceeds \$40,000,000 and to Ironco, it's worth \$9,000,000. These contracts will generate over 9,000 hours of work at Ironco and will result in the employment of about 75 additional workers.

Construction of these projects was to begin the week of May 4th, but has been put on "indefinite hold" by the developer until the Commission settles the Solar Alliance issue. As a result, that action has put our plans to bring back most, if not all, of the employees we have laid off since December, 2008 at a dead stop. In fact, where Ironco was looking to increase activity at our plant, we are now considering shutting down the construction division and laying off more workers as a direct result of this issue being unsettled.

We are hereby expressing our serious concern that any unnecessary delay in setting a hearing date or in any way prolonging a decision on Docket No. E-20633A-08-0513 will have a significant and deleterious impact on the ASU and U of A contracts as well as other projects funded through the use of SSAs. We pray the Judge and the Commission are able to render a determination on this matter as soon as possible so ours and other contracts are not put at risk and we can put unemployed Arizonans back to work.
