PROCEDURAL ORDER
GRANTING ADMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 19, 2009, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Laura M. Kam, an attorney with DLA Piper LLP (US) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice for Elizabeth Baird of O'Melveny & Meyers LLP in the above-captioned matter, on behalf of the Respondent, Banc of America Securities LLC and Banc of America Investment Services, Inc. 
