

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE INTRASTATE INTERCHANGE AND NON-SWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGES TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES BY EMC TELECOM CORPORATION.**  
Docket No. T-20615A-08-0429  
EMC Telecom Corporation ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide intrastate interchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona.  
The application, copies of which are available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the Commission located at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85001, and 1333 North Carson Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85016, and on the Internet at the Commission's website (<http://www.arizona.gov>) using the docket function. Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the proceedings and participate in the hearing. You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding if you may make a statement for the record. Interventions shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R13-1-145, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before October 15, 2008. If you wish to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send a copy of the motion to Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record. The motion must contain the following:  
1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address, and telephone number of any other party upon whom you wish service of documents to be made.  
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (as a customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, a competitor, etc.).  
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to the Applicant, or to counsel, and to all parties of record in the case.  
A.A.C. R13-1-145 governs the granting of motions to intervene. The granting of intervention among other things entitles a party to present evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement for the record of the proceeding.
