To the ACC: The proposed power line planned by ssvec, should not be allowed without a complete feasibility study in order to determine the environmental impacts. Several alternate, and more cost effective proposals have been put forward by community groups in the area, including adding solar to render the SSEVC proposal moot. I ask the ACC to force the utility to come up with a forward looking plan that includes using existing lines and adding solar panels to provide for the areas needs.
