Page 4, after line 11, INSERT a new Finding of Fact to read:

“In order to protect TEP’s low income residential customers from an increase in their monthly bills, we believe that any residential customer on a TEP low income discount rate should not be charged the DSM rate at this time. The monies that TEP would otherwise recover from the low income residential customers should be retained in TEP’s DSM account and be dealt with in a future rate case or in the 2010 adjutor docket. This initiative would have no effect on the DSM rate all other retail customers would pay at this time.”

Page 5, after line 2, insert a new Ordering Paragraph to read:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any residential customer on a Tucson Electric Power Company low income discount rate shall not be charged the Demand-Side Management rate and the monies that Tucson Electric Power Company would otherwise recover from the low income residential customers shall be retained in Tucson Electric Power Company’s Demand-Side Management account and be dealt with in a future rate case or in the 2010 adjutor docket.

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Tucson Electric Power Company shall provide appropriate notice of the Commission’s consideration of this matter (exempting low income customers for DSM and recovery of DSM funds not paid by low income customers to its customers and all parties of record in its last permanent rate case.”
