PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 4, 2009, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Dona Kuryanowicz, ("Respondent") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

The Respondent was duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On March 9, 2009, a request for hearing was filed by the Respondent.

On March 13, 2009, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on April 9, 2009.

On April 9, 2009, the Division appeared with counsel and Respondent appeared on her own behalf at the pre-hearing conference. The parties are conducting discussions to resolve the proceeding and stipulated that a status conference should be scheduled in approximately 45 days. By Procedural Order, a status conference was scheduled on May 28, 2009.

On May 28, 2009, at the status conference, the Division appeared with counsel and Respondent appeared on her own behalf. The Division's counsel indicated that the parties have been unable to reach an agreement and requested that a hearing be scheduled on the issues raised in the Notice.

Accordingly, a hearing should be scheduled as requested.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **hearing** shall be held on **August 4, 2009, at**
2 **9:30 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, Room 100, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall also reserve **August 5, 6 and 11, 2009**, for
4 additional days of hearing, if necessary.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **Division and Respondents shall exchange copies of**
6 **their Exhibits and Witness Lists**, with courtesy copies provided to the presiding Administrative
7 Law Judge, by **July 1, 2009**.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ex parte rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
9 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
10 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

11 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the**
12 **Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law**
13 **and admission *pro hac vice*.**

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
15 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
16 ruling at hearing.
