**WORLDCOM'S MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME**

WorldCom, Inc. ("WorldCom") moves for an extension of time to respond to the questions contained in the procedural order issued in the above matter on February 13, 2001. The procedural order approves a request from Staff of the Commission to commence this generic investigation for the purpose of obtaining comments from interested parties and members of industry concerning the implementation of number pooling and other number conservation methods in Arizona. The order requested that written comments in response to the 12 questions be submitted by parties to the Commission by March 7, 2001.


WorldCom requests an extension of time until March 21, 2001 to respond to the questions posed in the procedural order. On February 28, 2001, WorldCom underwent significant downsizing. All of the people who assisted WorldCom in Arizona and the

1 western region on NPA, NXX and other numbering issues were laid off. Due to these
2 sudden and unannounced changes in the personnel assigned to Arizona and the western
3 region who addressed numbering issues, and particularly questions such as those posed in
4 the procedural order, WorldCom will need additional time to assemble data and other
5 information for its response. WorldCom believes that the requested time will be sufficient
6 for it to prepare its written comments and other responses to the procedural order.
7 WorldCom is informed, and authorized to state, that the Staff does not oppose this
8 extension of time requested in this motion.

11 WHEREFORE, WorldCom requests this motion be granted and that it be
12 authorized to file responses to the 12 questions posed in the procedural order by March 21,
