A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the application of UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS Electric" or "Applicant") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility authorizing an upgrade of an existing 115 kV Transmission Line to 138 kV and approximately 4 to 5.5 miles of new 138 kV line, connecting the existing Vail Substation near the intersection of Interstate-10 and Rita Road, in the City of Tucson, Pima County Arizona, to the existing Valencia Substation at White Park Drive and Grand Avenue in the City of Nogales, Santa Cruz County, Arizona (the "Project"). The hearing will be held at the Esplendor Resort at Rio Rico, 1069 Camino Caralampi, Rio Rico, Arizona 85648. The hearing is scheduled to begin Tuesday June 2, 2009 at 9:30 a.m., and to continue as necessary on Wednesday June 3, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. and Thursday June 4, 2009 at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. on all days. Additional hearing days, if necessary, will be noticed on the Applicant and Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") websites.

PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN AFTER OPENING STATEMENTS AND AS PERMITTED BY THE COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN. IN ADDITION, A SEPARATE EVENING PUBLIC COMMENT SESSION WILL BE HELD JUNE 2, 2009, AT 6:00 P.M. ALSO AT THE ESPLENDOR RESORT, 1069 CAMINO CARALAMPI, RIO RICO, ARIZONA 85648.

The Project consists of replacing approximately 25 to 29 miles of an older single-circuit 115 kV line with new single-circuit 138 kV transmission line, and constructing approximately 4 to 5.5 miles of new single-circuit 138 kV line to facilitate a new interconnection for the Santa Cruz County service area. A general location map of the Applicant's proposed route, described herein, is set forth below.

The Project is proposed to originate at the existing Vail Substation operated by Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP"), in T.16S., R.15E., Section 4 near Interstate 10 and Rita Road within the City of Tucson. A new line will extend approximately 4 to 5.5 miles, depending on the selected route, southwesterly to connect with the existing UNS Electric transmission line. The existing transmission line is currently operating at 115 kV, but was designed to operate at 138 kV. It will remain as presently constructed from that connection approximately 26 to 28 miles south to the Kantor Substation near Tubac (per Line Siting Case No. 78 approved in Decision No. 56097). Upon the Project's completion, that existing line will operate at 138 kV.

From Kantor Substation the existing 115 KV line will be rebuilt on steel monopoles and as a 138 KV transmission line:

- for approximately 13.4 to 14.9 miles from the Kantor Substation southerly to the Cañez Substation;
- for approximately 3.3 to 3.6 miles from the Canez Substation southerly to the Sonoita Substation; and
- for approximately 8.3 to 10.1 miles from the Sonoita Substation southerly to the Valencia Substation in Nogales.

Both preferred and alternative alignments for the rebuild portions and the 4 to 5.5 mile new portion from the Vail Substation for the Project have been submitted by the Applicant.

More complete maps, along with more detailed textual descriptions of the proposed route are available in the Application and on the Applicant's website. The Application that includes detailed maps of the proposed Project is on file with the Docket Control Center of the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Suite 108, Phoenix Arizona, 85007, and 400 West Congress Street, Suite 221, Tucson, Arizona 85701 in addition to the three locations above.

The Committee may conduct a tour of the Project area and the proposed routes – most likely to occur on June 3, 2009 starting at 8:30 a.m. If a tour is conducted, a map and itinerary for the tour will be available at the hearings. Members of the public may follow the Committee in their own private vehicles. During the tour, the Committee may hear brief testimony at stops on the tour from one or more witnesses concerning where the stops are located, what is visible at the stops and the relevance of the location and view to the proposed routes of the transmission

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the Application of Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility authorizing the Bagdad 115kV Transmission Line Relocation Project (“Project”) in Yavapai County, Arizona. The hearing will be held at the Hampton Inn & Suites, 2000 North Litchfield Road, Goodyear, Arizona, 85395, (623) 536-1313, beginning on Monday, May 18, 2009, at 9:30 a.m. and continuing, if necessary, on Tuesday, May 19, 2009, at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. Additional hearing days, if necessary, will be noticed on the Arizona Corporation Commission (“ACC”) website. The ACC website is www.azcc.gov/AZ_Power_Plant/LineSiting-Calendar.asp. Public comment will be taken at the beginning of each hearing day.

The Committee may conduct a tour of the Project area and the proposed route on a future date. If a tour is conducted, a map and itinerary for the tour will be available at the hearings. Members of the public may follow the Committee in their own private vehicles. During any tour, the Committee may hear brief testimony at stops on the tour from one or more witnesses concerning where the stops are located, what is visible at the stops and the relevance of the location and view to the Proposed Route of the transmission line in the Application. No other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur.

The Project consists of approximately 5 miles of 115kV transmission line to be relocated to approximately 1 mile south of the existing location. A general location map of the Project study area and Applicant's Proposed Route containing references to the route described herein is set forth below.

The Proposed Route originates at an existing capacitor bank station, located 0.5 miles west of the Town of Bagdad in Section 10, Township 14 North, Range 9 West, G&SRB&M. The Proposed Route terminates at an existing mine substation, located 3 miles northwest of the Town of Bagdad in Section 31, Township 15 North, Range 9 West, G&SRB&M. The Applicant requests a 200-foot corridor, 100 feet on either side of the shown centerline.




