PROCEDURAL ORDER

10 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

11 On October 26, 2007, Wholesale Carrier Services, Inc. ("WCSI") filed with the Arizona
 12 Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and
 13 Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications
 14 services.

15 On November 23, 2007, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") issued a Letter of
 16 Insufficiency and First Set of Data Requests to WCSI.

17 On January 17, 2008, WCSI filed responses to Staff's First Set of Data Requests.

18 On June 18, 2008, Staff issued a Letter of Insufficiency and Second Set of Data Requests.

19 On April 22, 2009, a Procedural Order was issued requiring Staff to file an update in this
 20 matter, including any appropriate recommendation as to how this matter should be resolved and
 21 whether this matter should be administratively closed.

22 On May 18, 2009, Staff filed an Update stating that WCSI's attorney had informed Staff by e-
 23 mail on May 11, 2009, that WCSI does not wish to continue with its application for a CC&N. Staff
 24 stated that Staff replied by e-mail and recommended that WCSI file a request to withdraw its
 25 application with Docket Control. Staff added that it does not object to WCSI's withdrawing its
 26 application and that, if WCSI files a request for withdrawal, Staff recommends that this matter be
 27 administratively closed.

1 On June 8, 2009, a Procedural Order was issued requiring Staff to file, by June 15, 2009, a
2 copy of the e-mail sent to Staff by WCSI's attorney.

3 On June 12, 2009, WCSI's attorney filed a letter requesting withdrawal of WCSI's
4 application.

5 Because WCSI has requested withdrawal of its application, Staff's recommendation to
6 administratively close this docket is appropriate and should be followed.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **the docket in this matter is hereby administratively**
8 **closed.**


