PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 24, 2009, Roger and Darlene Chantel ("Complainants") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Complaint ("Complaint") against Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Respondent").

On April 10, 2009, the Respondent filed its Response to Formal Complaint and Motion to Dismiss Complaint.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
8 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*
9 *hac vice*.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or
11 waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
12 hearing.
