14 On May 29, 2009, Verizon California, Inc., Verizon Long Distance, LLC, Verizon Enterprises
15 Solutions, Frontier Communications Corporation, New Communications of the Southwest, Inc., and
16 New Communications Online and Long Distance, Inc. (together, the "Applicants"), filed with the
17 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a joint application for approval of the transfer of
18 Verizon Communications, Inc.'s, local exchange and long distance services, provided in Arizona by
19 Verizon California, Inc., to companies to be owned and controlled by Frontier Communications
20 Corporation.

21 On June 23, 2009, the Applicants filed a Request for Expedited Procedural Conference.


22 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **telephonic Procedural Conference** shall commence
