PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 23, 2008, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Richard Bradford and Cindy (Bradford) White, husband and wife (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts

On October 8, 2008, the Commission issued Decision Nos. 70544 and 70545, a Consent Order involving Ms. White and a Default Order involving Mr. Bradford, respectively.

On March 4, 2009, Ms. White filed a letter requesting that the Commission reconsider Decision No. 70544 with respect to her Consent Order. She further indicated she wished to request a hearing.

On March 19, 2009, the Division filed a Motion to schedule a procedural conference to discuss possible reconsideration of Decision No. 70544.

On April 7, 2009, a procedural conference was convened with the Division represented by counsel and Respondent appeared on her own behalf. The Division and Respondent White discussed the nature of the reconsideration of Decision No. 70544. Respondent further requested that a hearing be scheduled if the matter is not resolved in the interim. A hearing is scheduled to convene on July 7 and 8, 2009, at the Commission's offices in Phoenix, Arizona.

1 As of the date of this Procedural Order, there is no state budget in place for fiscal year 2010,  
2 which begins July 1, 2009. Given the possibility of a State shutdown and in an effort to ensure that  
3 the parties and other interested persons do not unnecessarily travel to the Commission's offices for  
4 the hearing, it is appropriate to require the parties and other interested persons to telephone the  
5 Commission's Hearing Division on July 6, 2009, to determine whether the Commission is operating  
6 and whether the hearing will take place as scheduled.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties and other interested persons who intend to  
8 attend the hearing in this matter shall call the Commission's Hearing Division, at (602) 542-4250,  
9 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on July 6, 2009, to determine whether the Hearing  
10 Division is operating and whether the hearing on July 7 and 8, 2009, will take place as scheduled.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
12 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's  
13 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,  
15 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by  
16 ruling at hearing.


