BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 5, 2008, Marshall Magruder filed a Formal Complaint with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") against UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE"), in which he alleged that UNSE failed to comply with provisions of Decision Nos. 70360 (May 27, 2008) (UNSE's last rate case), 61793 (June 29, 1999) (dismissing Complaint brought by the City of Nogales against Citizens Utilities' ("Citizens")), and 62011 (November 2, 1999) (approving settlement agreement between Citizens and the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") regarding Citizens' Plan of Action ("POA") to rectify service problems in Santa Cruz County).¹

By Procedural Order dated June 26, 2009, a Procedural Conference was set for July 16, 2009, however, the Procedural Order inadvertently omitted the starting time of the Procedural Conference.




