Dear Commissioners,

I am a H.V.A.C. Contractor licensed in Arizona for 21 years and in good standing with the Registrar of Contractors and BBB, Bonded, properly Insured, a Carrier Equipment Factory Authorized Dealer and my Service Technicians are NATE Certified.

Upon learning of the newly revised rebate program (see above referenced) offered by APS and SRP to their electric consumers purchasing new replacement Cooling and Heating equipment, I have been informed by APS and SRP I have to NOW become a member of the Electric League of Arizona and the Arizona Heat Pump Council to offer the rebate program.

Becoming a member of the Electric League and the Heat Pump Council requires large monetary fees along with fees charged for classes. To join these organizations my estimated cost would be \$3,000.00 with classes per year. In today's economic times this is extremely expensive for my small H.V.A.C. business so I can offer my customers the APS and SRP rebates when selling and installing new replacement equipment.

It was highly implied during my conversation with Mr. Jim Holbrook, of APS, that if I do not become a member of the Electric League and the Heat Pump Council my H.V.A.C. business will be branded as doing substandard work. Therefore, the intent by APS is to have a preferential H.V.A.C contractor membership thru the Electric League and the Heat Pump Council with the membership obtaining work by offering APS rebates to homeowners with APS giving a financial kickback to the contractor, and drive non-members out of business. May I remind you this is racketeering.

I am requesting a STAY and HOLD on the above listed Decision and Dockets.

I am, also, recommending a dismemberment and abandonment of the Arizona Heat Pump Council so no further preferred list of contractors exist.

I await your decision and reply.
