

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER AUTHORIZING YARNELL WATER IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION TO INCUR INDEBTEDNESS AND TO ENCUMBER ITS REAL PROPERTY AND UTILITY PLANT AND SYSTEM TO SECURE SUCH INDEBTEDNESS**

Yarnell Water Improvement Association ("Company") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an order authorizing the Company to (1) incur indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$767,000.00 and to encumber its real property and utility plant and system to secure such indebtedness for the purposes described in the Application; and (2) to enter into the necessary agreements and take action as may be required to obtain the grant funding described in the Application. The loan and grant funds will be used to pay for the cost of improvements to the Company's existing water system. The source of funding for the project is the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The Application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the office of the Commission in Phoenix, Arizona, and the Company's offices in Yarnell, Arizona.

Intervention in the Commission's proceedings on the Application shall be permitted to any person entitled by law to intervene and having a direct substantial interest in this matter. Persons desiring to intervene must file a Motion to Intervene with the Commission which must be served upon the Company and which, at a minimum, shall contain the following information:

1. The name, address and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different that the intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding.
3. Whether the proposed intervenor desires a formal evidentiary hearing on the Application and the reasons for such a hearing.
4. A statement certifying that a copy of the Motion to Intervene has been mailed to the Company.

The granting of Motions to Intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all Motions to Intervene must be filed on, or before, the 15th day after this notice.
