PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On December 31, 2008, in Docket no. W-03211A-08-0621 (“Finance Docket”) F. Wayne and Dorothy Thompson dba West Village Water Company (“West Village”) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) requesting authority to incur debt in the amount of \$525,000 to finance improvements for West Village’s well, pumping equipment, and distribution system.

On the same date, West Village filed an application, in Docket No. W-03211A-08-0622 (“Rate Docket”), seeking a permanent increase in rates in the amount of \$99,273 or 310.85% over 2007 test year revenues.

On January 6, 2009, West Village filed a Motion to Consolidate the Rate Docket and the Finance Docket (“Motion”).

On March 16, 2009, by Procedural Orders docketed in both dockets, the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) was directed to file a response to West Village’s Motion.

On March 26, 2009, Staff filed a Response to the Motion, stating that Staff has no objections to the consolidation of the dockets as the matters are substantially related.

On April 1, 2009, Staff filed a Letter of Sufficiency stating that West Village’s rate

1 application had met the sufficiency requirements outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code and  
2 that West Village had been classified as a Class D utility.

3 On April 20, 2009, by Procedural Order, Docket Nos. W-03211A-08-0621 and W-03211A-  
4 08-0622 were consolidated.

5 On April 21, 2009, West Village filed an Affidavit Verifying Customer Notice of Finance  
6 Application.

7 On May 27, 2009, West Village filed a Motion for Extension of Time ("Motion"), which  
8 requested that Staff's deadline for filing the Staff Report be extended from June 15, 2009, to July 31,  
9 2009. The Motion explained that the extension of time would allow the Arizona Department of  
10 Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") sufficient time to evaluate and report on West Village's water  
11 system.

12 On May 29, 2009, Staff filed a Response to the Motion stating that Staff did not oppose the  
13 request for an extension of time.

14 On May 29, 2009, by Procedural Order, West Village's Motion was granted and the deadline  
15 for filing the Staff Report was extended to July 31, 2009.

16 On July 14, 2009, West Village filed a second Motion for Extension of Time, requesting that  
17 Staff's deadline for filing its Staff Report be extended from July 31, 2009, to September 30, 2009,  
18 and stating that additional time is needed for ADEQ to finalize West Village's system evaluation.

19 On July 15, 2009, Staff filed a Response to West Village's second Motion for Extension of  
20 Time stating Staff believes the extension of time is reasonable under the circumstances and Staff does  
21 not oppose the request to extend the time deadline.

22 Good cause has been shown for granting West Village's Motion for an Extension of Time.

23 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **West Village shall immediately notify** Staff when the  
24 ADEQ report is available, but no later than seven (7) days after receiving said report from ADEQ.



1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Staff shall file a **Staff Report** in this matter within 60 days  
2 of receiving West Village's notification that ADEQ has completed its evaluation of the Company's  
3 water system.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the timeclock is suspended.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
6 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
