PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 4, 2009, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Dona Kuryanowicz, ("Respondent") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

The Respondent was duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On March 9, 2009, a request for hearing was filed by the Respondent.

On March 13, 2009, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on April 9, 2009.

On April 9, 2009, the Division appeared with counsel and Respondent appeared on her own behalf at the pre-hearing conference. The parties are conducting discussions to resolve the proceeding and stipulated that a status conference should be scheduled in approximately 45 days. By Procedural Order, a status conference was scheduled on May 28, 2009.

On May 28, 2009, at the status conference, the Division appeared with counsel and Respondent appeared on her own behalf. The Division's counsel indicated that the parties have been unable to reach an agreement and requested that a hearing be scheduled on the issues raised in the Notice.

1 On May 29, 2009, by Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled on August 4, 2009.

2 On July 20, 2009, the Division filed a Motion to Vacate Hearing Date ("Motion") which
3 states that the parties have agreed upon a Consent Order which will be presented for Commission
4 approval at its August 13, 2009, Open Meeting. The Division further stated that if the Consent Order
5 is not approved, the Division will request that a new hearing date be set.

6 Accordingly, the Division's Motion should be granted and the hearing vacated.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Division's Motion is hereby granted and **the**
8 **hearing scheduled on August 4, 2009, in this proceeding is hereby vacated.**

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Division shall file a Motion to Reschedule the Hearing
10 if the Consent Order is not approved by the Commission.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ex parte rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
12 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
13 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the**
15 **Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law**
16 **and admission *pro hac vice*.**

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
18 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
19 ruling at hearing.
