IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF SOLARCITY CORPORATION FOR A DETERMINATION THAT WHEN IT PROVIDES SOLAR SERVICE TO ARIZONA SCHOOLS, GOVERNMENTS, AND NON-PROFIT ENTITIES IT IS NOT ACTING AS A PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION PURSUANT TO ART. 15, SECTION 2 OF THE ARIZONA CONSTITUTION.

PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 2, 2009, SolarCity Corporation (“SolarCity” or “Company”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) an application to determine that when SolarCity provides solar service to Arizona schools, governments, and non-profit entities it is not acting as a public service corporation pursuant to Article 15, Section 2 of the Arizona Constitution (“Application”). The Application requested expedited consideration of two specific Solar Service Agreements (“SSAs”) it has entered into with the Scottsdale Unified School District.

On July 10, 2009, a telephonic procedural conference was held for the limited purpose of (1) discussing issues related to public notice of the Application, and (2) a suitable date for a procedural conference to discuss an appropriate procedure for processing the Application. Counsel for SolarCity and the Commission’s Utilities Division (“Staff”) appeared telephonically and discussed those issues.

On July 10, 2009, following the telephonic procedural conference, a procedural order was issued setting a procedural conference to be held on July 16, 2009, for the purpose of discussing an appropriate procedure for processing the Application. The procedural order also directed publication and mailing of notice of the Application and the July 16, 2009, procedural conference.

On July 13, 2009, the Company filed a Notice of Filing Service List and Form of Notice.

On July 13, 2009, the Residential Utility Consumer Office (“RUCO”) filed an Application to

1 Intervene.

2 On July 14, 2009, the Salt River Project and Improvement District (“SRP”) and Arizona
3 Public Service Company (“APS”) each filed a Motion to Intervene.

4 On July 15, 2009, the Company filed a Notice of Filing Affidavit of Publication and
5 Certification of Mailing.

6 On July 16, 2009, Tucson Electric Power Company (“TEP”) and UNS Electric, Inc. (“UNS
7 Electric”) jointly filed a Motion to Intervene.

8 On July 16, 2009, Navopache Electric Cooperative (“Navopache”) filed an Application to
9 Intervene.

10 On July 16, 2009, K.R. Saline & Associates, PLC filed a request to be added to service list.

11 On July 16, 2009, SolarCity filed a Notice of filing Supplemental Exhibit.

12 On July 17, 2009, Freeport-McMoRan Copper and Gold Inc. (“Freeport-McMoRan”) and
13 Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition (“AECC”) jointly filed an Application for Leave to
14 Intervene.

15 On July 17, 2009, Mohave Electric Cooperative (“Mohave”) filed an Application to Intervene.

16 A procedural conference was convened as scheduled on July 16, 2009. Appearances were
17 entered through counsel for SolarCity, APS, SRP, TEP, UNS, Navopache, Mohave, Freeport-
18 McMoRan, AECC, RUCO, and Staff. Five of those entities had already requested intervention, and
19 counsel for the others indicated that they intended to file intervention requests. Counsel for SolarCity
20 indicated that SolarCity did not oppose the interventions. Intervention was granted at the procedural
21 conference with the understanding that a procedural order would follow formally granting the
22 interventions.

23 SolarCity’s proposal for a truncated procedure would limit discovery to one round ending by
24 July 21, 2009, with responses due July 27, 2009. The proposal did not include any prefiled
25 testimony, and called for a briefing schedule ending on August 11, 2009, and a Decision by the
26 Commission no later than August 31, 2009.

27 There was general agreement among those present at the procedural conference that a
28 Commission determination on the issue of whether an entity is a public service corporation requires

1 an application of the factors set forth in *Natural Gas Serv. Co. v. Serv-Yu Cooperative*¹ to the
2 particular facts of each case any time an entity requests relief similar to that requested by SolarCity in
3 the Application. There was also general agreement that such an adjudication process would require
4 an evidentiary hearing in order for the Commission to have an adequate record upon which to base its
5 Decision. The general response to SolarCity's proposed procedural schedule was that it would not
6 allow sufficient time for the development of an evidentiary record necessary to support the requested
7 relief.

8 Staff stated that it believes there is merit in SolarCity's request to expedite the processing of
9 Application. Staff indicated, however, that the time required to complete the discovery and analysis
10 necessary for Staff to prepare a Staff Report and recommendation to the Commission would take
11 considerably more time than the expedited timeframe requested by SolarCity would provide. Staff
12 therefore opposed SolarCity's proposed truncated procedural schedule for processing the Application.

13 Staff proposed an alternative form of relief that would meet the Company's stated need to
14 quickly move forward with a Commission determination regarding the Scottsdale Unified School
15 District SSAs. Staff's procedural proposal consists two tracks. The first track would consist of an
16 initial evaluation of the SSAs under the criteria used for analysis of special contracts. The second,
17 parallel, track would consist of an evaluation of the Application as a whole under the criteria for
18 adjudication not a public service corporation. Staff explained that its proposed process could result in
19 SolarCity receiving provisional authorization, if the Commission believes it to be in the public
20 interest, to move forward with the Scottsdale Unified School District SSAs prior to completing the
21 processing of the Company's adjudication request. Staff indicated that this two-track process could
22 be accomplished without prejudice to the Company's legal position that it is not a public service
23 corporation.

24 Staff's proposal includes Commission consideration of the SSAs as special contracts at an
25 Open Meeting of the Commission prior to an adjudication hearing. Staff's proposed timeframe for
26 the special contract analysis of the two SSAs includes the filing of a Staff Report and Recommended
27

1 Order on August 11, 2009. Staff indicated that the Staff Report and Proposed Order would include
2 Staff's evaluation of the SSAs, and Staff's recommendations regarding whether the Commission
3 should grant the Company provisional authority to move forward with the Scottsdale Unified School
4 District SSAs pending completion of the processing of the Company's adjudication request. Staff's
5 proposed timeframe would allow a deadline of August 21, 2009, for filing exceptions to the Proposed
6 Order, which would allow Commission consideration of the Proposed Order as early as the Regular
7 Open Meeting of the Commission scheduled for August 25, 2009.

8 Staff believes its proposed adjudication hearing schedule would allow sufficient time for the
9 evidentiary inquiry and analysis necessary to inform the parties' recommendations to the
10 Commission. Staff's proposed hearing schedule for the adjudication analysis begins with the filing of
11 direct testimony by the Company in August, 2009, and includes time for subsequent discovery and
12 the preparation of direct testimony to be filed in September, 2009, by Staff and intervenors. Staff
13 emphasized that meeting its proposed expedited hearing schedule would require extensive
14 cooperation from SolarCity in responding to discovery requests in an expedited manner.

15 SolarCity and the parties present at the procedural conference were in general agreement with
16 Staff's procedural proposal and associated timeframes.

17 Staff's two-track proposal for evaluating the Application would allow the Commission to
18 evaluate the SSAs under the standards used to evaluate special contracts concurrently with the
19 processing of the Application, which will include a full adjudication analysis, on a parallel track. The
20 two-track proposal is reasonable, in that it will allow expedited Commission consideration of the
21 SSAs as special contracts, at the same time that discovery and hearing preparation begins for the
22 adjudication analysis, which by its nature, requires a longer timeframe to complete. Staff's proposal,
23 while abbreviated, should provide time to develop an appropriate evidentiary record for a
24 Commission determination on the adjudication request, as long as the Company is cooperative in
25 responding to discovery requests in an expedited manner.

26 Staff's procedural proposal is reasonable and will be adopted.

27 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that intervention is hereby granted to the Residential Utility
28 Consumer Office, the Salt River Project and Improvement District, Arizona Public Service Company,

1 Tucson Electric Power Company, UNS Electric, Inc., Navopache Electric Cooperative, Freeport-
2 McMoRan Copper and Gold Inc., Arizonans for Electric Choice and Competition, and Mohave
3 Electric Cooperative.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Utilities Division shall file, by **August**
5 **11, 2009**, a **Staff Report and Recommended Order** that includes an evaluation of the two Solar
6 Service Agreements that SolarCity Corporation has entered into with the Scottsdale Unified School
7 District, and a recommendation to the Commission for action thereon.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties are hereby put on notice that the Commission
9 may schedule consideration of the Recommended Order on the Solar Service Agreements as early as
10 the Regular Open Meeting of the Commission scheduled for August 25, 2009.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **hearing** on the relief requested in the Application is
12 hereby scheduled to commence on **October 14, 2009**, commencing at **10:00 a.m.**, or as soon
13 thereafter as is practicable, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing
14 Room #1 Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a pre-hearing conference shall be held on **October 9, 2009**,
16 **at 1:30 p.m.**, at the Commission's Phoenix offices, for the purpose of scheduling witnesses and the
17 conduct of the hearing.

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **direct testimony** and associated exhibits **to be presented**
19 **at hearing on behalf of SolarCity** shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **August 24,**
20 **2009.**

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the **Staff Report and/or any testimony** and associated
22 exhibits to be presented at hearing on behalf of Staff shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before
23 **September 23, 2009.**

24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **testimony** and associated exhibits **to be presented at**
25 **hearing on behalf of intervenors** shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **September 23,**
26 **2009.**

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties shall address the issues raised by Commissioner
2 Mayes at the July 16, 2009, procedural conference.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **all filings shall be made by 4:00 p.m. on the date the**
4 **filing is due.**

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **objections to testimony or exhibits that have been**
6 **prefiled as of September 23, 2009, shall be made before or at the October 9, 2009, pre-hearing**
7 **conference.**

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all testimony filed shall include a table of contents which
9 lists the issues discussed.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any substantive corrections, revisions, or supplements to
11 prefiled testimony shall be reduced to writing and filed no later than five calendar days before the
12 witness is scheduled to testify.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall prepare a brief, written summary of the
14 prefiled testimony of each of their witnesses and shall file each summary at least two working days
15 before the witness is scheduled to testify.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that copies of summaries shall be served upon the
17 Administrative Law Judge, the Commissioners, and the Commissioners' aides as well as the parties
18 of record.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105,
20 except that **all motions to intervene must be filed on or before August 10, 2009.**

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that discovery shall be as permitted by law and the rules and
22 regulations of the Commission, except that any objection to discovery requests shall be made within
23 5 calendar days of receipt² and responses to discovery requests shall be made within 7 calendar days
24 of receipt. The response time may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties involved if the
25 request requires an extensive compilation effort.

26 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for discovery requests, objections, and answers, if a
27

1 receiving party requests service to be made electronically, and the sending party has the technical
2 capability to provide service electronically, service to that party shall be made electronically.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in the alternative to filing a written motion to compel
4 discovery, any party seeking resolution of a discovery dispute may telephonically contact the
5 Commission's Hearing Division to request a date for a procedural hearing to resolve the discovery
6 dispute; that upon such a request, a procedural hearing will be convened as soon as practicable; and
7 that the party making such a request shall forthwith contact all other parties to advise them of the
8 hearing date and shall at the hearing provide a statement confirming that the other parties were
9 contacted.³

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any motions which are filed in this matter and which are
11 not ruled upon by the Commission within 20 calendar days of the filing date of the motion shall be
12 deemed denied.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any responses to motions shall be filed within five calendar
14 days of the filing date of the motion.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any replies shall be filed within five calendar days of the
16 filing date of the response.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SolarCity shall provide public notice of the proceedings
18 and hearing on the Application in the following form and style, with the heading in no less than 18-
19 point bold type and the body in no less than 10-point regular type:

27 **Summary**

28 On July 2, 2009, SolarCity Corporation ("SolarCity" or "Applicant") filed with the
Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a determination
that when it provides solar service to Arizona schools, governments, and non-profit

1 entities under Solar Service Agreements (“SSAs”) it is not acting as a public service
2 corporation pursuant to Article 15, Section 2 of the Arizona Constitution
3 (“Application”).

4 The Commission’s Utilities Division is reviewing two SSAs SolarCity has entered into
5 with the Scottsdale Unified School District and will make a recommendation to the
6 Commission regarding the SSAs in a Staff Report and Recommended Order.

7 The Commission’s Utilities Division is also reviewing the Application in regard to
8 SolarCity’s requested relief, and will make a separate recommendation to the
9 Commission. Other parties granted intervention will also have an opportunity to make
10 recommendations to the Commission regarding the Application. The Commission will
11 consider the recommendations of all parties, but is not bound by those
12 recommendations in determining the appropriate relief to be granted.


