Supplemental Responses to Requests for Admissions

- A. Admit or Deny: The company engaged in activities referred to as “wash,” “round trip” or “sell/buyback” trading. This trading involves the sale of an electricity product to another company together with a simultaneous purchase of the same product at the same price.

RESPONSE: In its initial response submitted May 31, 2002 in this docket, Reliant¹ identified and provided information relating to its only “roundtrip” trade transacted in the WSCC in 2000-2001, which trade was executed in the cash market with a commercial counterparty at market price for the purpose of increasing volume. To further the Commission Staff’s investigation, Reliant is supplementing its response to provide transaction information and documentation relating to two 1999 roundtrip electricity transactions of the same type, both of which were executed within a reasonable range of market prices for the purpose of increasing volume (the “1999 Palo Verde transactions”). Reliant did not discuss these transactions in its initial response because, although they occurred at the Palo Verde point in Arizona, they fell outside of the Request period. These transactions have been discussed publicly in Reliant’s SEC filings and in press releases from Reliant and other parties, however, so Reliant is providing this supplement to inform the Commission Staff of the transaction details for Reliant’s 1999 roundtrip trades in the West. In addition, Reliant is supplementing its May 31, 2002 response by providing transaction information relative to the same-day, non-roundtrip transactions described in that response. This supplemental spreadsheet identifies the previously referenced non-roundtrip trades and contains a key describing the characteristics that distinguish the listed transactions from the roundtrip trades.

¹ This response is provided on behalf of Reliant Energy Services, Inc. and Reliant Energy Power Generation, Inc., the affiliates of Reliant Resources, Inc. and Reliant Energy, Incorporated that transact in wholesale bulk power markets within the U.S. portion of the Western Systems Coordinating Council (“WSCC”).

B. If you so admit, provide transaction by transaction details for all such transactions your company engaged in, including, but not limited to, the following:

1. Indicate the methods and rationale used to arrive at the value or compensation of such transactions.

RESPONSE: The 1999 Palo Verde transactions were entered into at market prices based on trades of the same products at the same points executed in the same time period. One transaction for a firm peak product for the month of September was traded at a price of \$38/MWh. The second transaction involved a buy and sell of a firm off-peak product for the month of November 1999 for \$20/MWh. Because prices for off-peak products are not published widely, Reliant has reviewed its internal price curves in effect at the time of the trade to confirm that like products were trading in the market in the same time period for prices of approximately \$19/MWh, a price within a reasonable range of Reliant's transaction price.

2. Indicate whether any such transactions were reported to Platt's, Bloomberg, or any organization that monitors, publishes or reports trading data (including bid-and-ask data) or publishes or reports prices or forward indices.

RESPONSE: After thorough investigation, Reliant concludes that it made no report of the 1999 Palo Verde transactions to Platts, Bloomberg, or any organization that monitors, publishes or reports trading data or publishes or reports prices or forward indices.²

4. Identify all traders that participated in such transactions, by name and position within your company, if employed by you, or by name and affiliation if they were not or are not presently employed by your company.

RESPONSE: See attached documents.

² Reliant does, of course, submit quarterly transaction reports to the Commission, which reports are made publicly available.

5. Identify how such transactions were executed (e.g., whether an electronic platform was used to initiate the sale, with the buy transaction subsequently arranged through a broker or by telephone).

RESPONSE: The Palo Verde transactions were executed directly with the counterparties without use of brokers or online trading platforms

To the extent that you wish to make a claim of privilege with respect to any responsive material, please provide an index of each of those materials, which includes the date of the each individual document, its title, its recipient(s) and its sender(s), a summary of the contents of the document, and the basis of the claim of privilege.

RESPONSE:

As part of its original submission of responses to this Commission on May 22, 2002, Reliant produced a 44-page slide presentation prepared by Perot Services Corporation. This document also was produced to the California Senate's Select Committee chaired by Senator Joseph Dunn, which had requested the production of much of the same material that was the subject of the Commission's May 8 Requests.

Reliant has identified no documents that would enable it to determine the exact date upon which it received a copy of the Perot Systems presentation, which is undated. The copy that Reliant produced to FERC and to Senator Dunn's Committee was located in the files of John Stout, a Reliant Senior Vice President. After an internal investigation, Reliant has not identified any other employees who recall seeing the document. Based on the contents of the document, Reliant believes that the document was received in connection with Perot Systems' sales and marketing efforts and was created in approximately the 1998 time frame.

In recent securities filings and public statements, Perot Systems indicated that this material was part of an unsuccessful sales effort by Perot Systems that began in 1997. Perot Systems also has stated that

substantially the same material was presented to California market participants other than Reliant, and that dissemination of this material had been approved by the California Power Exchange.

Perot Systems conducted a workshop for Reliant's West power traders on June 26, 1998 to provide an overview of the operation of the California energy markets. However, the employees that Reliant has identified as potentially having attended the workshop do not remember seeing or discussing the contents of the 44-page Perot Systems document prior to June 5, 2002. Accordingly, Reliant does not believe that this document was the subject of that workshop. Furthermore, consistent with public statements made by a spokesperson for the California Independent System Operator Corporation, Reliant has no reason to believe that the Perot Systems document contained anything other than publicly available market information and discussion of previously identified flaws in the design of the California wholesale market. In addition, as the document itself indicates, the identified protocol gaps and other flaws were corrected by the California Independent System Operator Corporation and the California Power Exchange Corporation.


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
