Subject: APS - service connection



Hello Mr. Pierce, my name is David Severson. I wrote one email to the Corporation Commission from the email site. I have heard nothing back so I'm going to write to each of you.

I purchased a piece of land in Yavapai County, near Seligman, Arizona. It is located in the Sierra Verde Ranch area. I have had a well dug to have water on the property. I have had a septic tank installed, and am ready to have a building built or a mobile home moved onto the property. My problem is that though the power is one lot away, it is 1320 feet away. When I called APS, and talked to April Schoenrad the person in charge of the area at Sierra Verde Ranch for APS, she told me that it would cost between \$20.00 to \$30.00 a foot to bring it in. Then there could be additional charges if a transformer was needed. She said the corporation commission was the one who said that the costs should go to the consumer, and changed the policy of them giving a 1,000 foot connection hookup, and forcing APS to make the consumer pay. It has not been easy to have a road built, install the septic system or have a well put in, but it seems defeating to have everyone against me. If there is any way to help to talk to APS for a power connection, I would sure appreciate it. I had been with them 30 years before moving, and was hoping that being a good customer might help. Please help me if possible. My 401 K is being depleted quickly, and I Need help.
