
26 Intervenors Local Unions 387, 640 and 769,

2 mistake in this regard.

3 In addition, please be advised that when Mr. Hoover
4 testifies at the upcoming hearing, he will explain the basis
5 for IBEW Locals 387, 640 and 769's unqualified support of
6 the adoption of proposed Settlement Agreement and, in
7 particular, the following specific paragraphs of the
8 proposed Settlement Agreement: ¶¶1.15, 7.4 and 13.4(a)(vi).
9 And while not addressed in his previously filed testimony,
10 Mr. Hoover is also in a unique position to address, from the
11 perspective of the employees of the Arizona Public Service
12 Company, a number of safety and reliability concerns
13 associated with the potential adoption of the California
14 approach *vis-á-vis* line extensions, a summary of which can
15 be located on page one (1) of the attachment to the "STAFF'S
16 NOTICE OF FILING REPLY TESTIMONY IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED
17 SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT" dated August 13, 2009.
