Page 8, line 26, INSERT:

“While we decline today to adopt the Solar Alliance’s proposal for addressing the under-utilization of the residential distributed generation funds, we agree that the program would benefit from changes that would allow more homeowners to participate in the program. Just as commercial distributed generation has benefitted tremendously from the introduction of the Production Based Incentives, we believe the residential distributed generation program could be propelled by a similar mechanism that allows homeowners to economically deploy solar energy on their rooftops. Therefore, we believe that Arizona Public Service Company should present to the Commission, as a supplement to its 2010 REST Implementation Plan, a proposal that is designed to improve the performance of the residential distributed generation program. Such a proposal could include a community solar program, targeted feed-in tariff or a residential distributed energy production based incentive.”

Page 9, line 8: INSERT New Ordering Paragraph: “Arizona Public Service Company shall present the Commission for its consideration, as a supplement to its 2010 REST Implementation Plan, a proposal that is designed to improve the performance of the residential distributed generation program. Such a proposal could include, but is not limited to, a community solar program, a targeted feed-in tariff or a residential distributed energy production based incentive.”
