This firm represents Mainspring Capital Group ("Mainspring"), a large Arizona land owner and developer. Mainspring is currently in the process of exploring the potential development of a utility- scale solar photovoltaic ("TV") project on a portion of their property located in Casa Grande, AZ. Mainspring hereby submits this letter in support of APS ' s proposed 2010 implementation plan for compliance with the Commission's Renewable Energy Standard.

Mainspring is supportive of APS's request to increase fUnding for renewable energy incentives and APS's request to "over comply" with the RES targets. Only by setting ambitious targets will Arizona be likely to achieve significant increases in renewable energy adoption. Mainspring believes that it is important for the Commission to approve this plan in order to allow the solar industry in Arizona to establish itself. The industry is at an important crossroads and failure to provide continued and expanded support via increased rebate incentive fUnds would be a critical blow to this burgeoning and increasingly important economic sector, Mainspring applauds APS and the Commission for their leadership to date on this issue and hopes that it will continue with the approval of this request.
