

The hearing will continue on Wednesday, October 7, 2009, at 8:30 a.m., if a tour is taken, otherwise it will begin at 9:30 a.m. If the hearing has not concluded, it will continue on Thursday, October 8, 2009, at 9:30 a.m. The hearing will adjourn at approximately 5:00 p.m. each day. Public comment will be taken during the hearing at times designated by the Chairman. Public comment also will be taken in a special evening session on October 6, 2009, at 6:00 p.m. at the same location. Additional days for the hearing may be set, or the hearing may conclude earlier than anticipated, depending upon the number of parties that intervene, the amount of testimony presented, the amount of public comment, and the time needed for deliberations by the Committee. Tara - As we discussed, here is some info on site choices for Case 149 (Saguaro-North Loop). This is the closest area to the south end of the Project, it's just desert all the way north from there until Casa Grande, which is many more miles from the north end of the Project.

The Omni allowed for lodging and dining at the same site as the hearing, no other facility in the area did. I enclosed a Google printout that shows the Omni and another motel, Red Roof, along with the other 'hits' in the area, Holiday Inn Express and Travelodge. None of those have meeting facilities or on-site restaurants.
