Dear Chairman Mayes and Commissioners;

On August 21, 2009, SolarCity Corporation filed its Exceptions to the August 14, 2009 Recommended Opinion and Order and Request for Continuation of Special Contract Approval on the Coronado High School SSA until the Commission's September Open Meeting (the "Exceptions"). As the full title to the Exceptions suggests, the Exceptions included a request that the Commission continue the SSA relating to Coronado High School until its Utilities Open Meeting in late September (the "Continuance Request"). Please accept this letter as SolarCity's formal request to withdraw its Continuance Request. As a result SolarCity is hopeful that the Commission will hear and approve both Solar Services Agreements that have been presented for consideration at tomorrow's Open Meeting. This matter was originally set for the August 25th Open Meeting before it was continued to the September 9th Securities Open Meeting and it has become apparent during this intervening time period that the requested continuance is unnecessary at this time.

SolarCity is extremely appreciative of the Commission and the Commission's Staff's time and believes that hearing each of these contracts together is the most efficient way of moving forward.

SolarCity is prepared to make this request again at tomorrow's hearing but wanted to give you notice of this request as quickly as possible.
