Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On August 29, 2006, Global Water – Santa Cruz Water Company (“Santa Cruz”) and Global Water – Palo Verde Utilities Company (“Palo Verde”) (jointly “Global Utilities” or “Applicants”) filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) a joint application for an extension of their respective Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate” or “CC&N”) in Pinal County, Arizona.

2. On June 13, 2008, the Commission issued Decision No. 70381, which approved Global Utilities’ application to extend its CC&N to include 13 square miles in Pinal County, Arizona. The Decision required Santa Cruz to file, among other things, the Approval to Construct (“ATC”) for the first well, storage facility, and distribution system for Phase I development in the Northwest Zone of the extension area by June 30, 2009.



1 June 30, 2010, to file the Approval to Construct ordered in Decision No. 70381, is reasonable and  
2 should be adopted.

3 **ORDER**

4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Global Water – Santa Cruz Water Company is hereby  
5 granted an extension of time to comply with Commission Decision No. 70381, until June 30, 2010, to  
6 file an Approval to Construct for the first well, storage facility, and distribution system for Phase 1  
7 development in the Northwest Zone of the extension area.


8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
