Duncan Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Duncan") is hereby filing its tariff pages for the Renewable Energy Standard ("RES") Tariff in compliance with the Arizona Corporation Commission RES Rules. Duncan has designed this RES Tariff to collect an amount of funds that are necessary to meet its portion of the RES goals defined in the Arizona Electric Power Cooperative's 2010 RES Implementation Plan that was filed on June 30, 2009 in Docket No. E-01773A-09-0335.

Duncan will waive the 30 day time provisions referenced in A.R.S. Section 40-367 and 40-250, (B), but requests that this application be processed as soon as possible due to the lack funds that are available for Duncan's Sun Watts Rebate Program.

RENEWABLE ENERGY STANDARD TARIFF

Effective Date:

Background

On November 14, 2006, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 69127 that contained a Renewable Energy Standard ("RES") that set forth annual renewable energy requirements for all affected electric utilities in the State of Arizona as well as a requirement that each affected electric utility file with the ACC for approval a RES Tariff to fund such renewable energy requirements.

Availability

In the Cooperative's Certificated Area where its facilities are of adequate capacity and the required phase and suitable voltage are in existence and are adjacent to the premises served.

Application

On all bills for all governmental and agricultural members/customers with multiple meters, a Renewable Energy Standard ("RES") Surcharge mandated by the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") will be assessed monthly at the lesser of per kilowatt-hour of retail electricity purchased by the consumer, or the maximum stated below:

Monthly Rate

Customer	kWh	Maximum
Governmental and Agricultural	\$.001663	\$24.70
Governmental and Agricultural metered demand is 3,000 kW or more for 3 consecutive months	\$.001663	\$74.10

On all bills in all other tariff service categories than those listed above, an RES Surcharge mandated by the Arizona Corporation Commission will be assessed monthly at the lesser of the per kilowatt-hour of retail electricity purchased by the consumer, or the maximum stated below:

Residential	\$.009477	\$2.00
Non-Residential	\$.009477	\$74.10
Non-Residential metered demand is 3,000 kW or more for 3 consecutive months	\$.009477	\$222.30

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In the case of unmetered services, Duncan Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Cooperative") shall, for purposes of billing the RES Surcharge and subject to the maximum assessment set forth above, use the lesser of (i) the load profile or otherwise estimated kWh required to provide the service in question; or (ii) the service's contract kWh.

Sun Watts Inspection Fees

Description	Fee
First Inspection	No charge
Second Inspection and subsequent inspections (if needed)	\$50.00

Additional inspection fees will be required when violations of the inter-connection requirements, the National Electric Code, and/or safety issues are found during an inspection that can not be corrected during the first or subsequent inspections.

The RES Surcharge is in addition to all other rates and charges applicable to service to the member/customer.
