**SECOND SUPPLEMENT TO
APPLICATION**

Through this filing, Verizon Enterprises Solutions ("VES") provides a further update to its Application to Discontinue Certain Competitive Telecommunications services in Arizona. Verizon and Frontier Communications recently filed an Application in Docket Nos. T-01846B-09-0274 *et al.* (the "Frontier Docket") in which, among other approvals, the parties seek approval to transfer current customers of VES within the territory of Verizon California, Inc. to a future subsidiary of Frontier Communications, New Communications Online and Long Distance, Inc. ("NewLD"). Subject to the Commission's approval in the Frontier Docket, those customers of VES that are transferred to NewLD will not be subject to the future discontinuance in this docket.

As noted in its prior Supplement to this Application, VES intends to delay the ultimate discontinuance of the remaining presubscribed long distance service customers. Prior to the ultimate discontinuance, VES will re-notice these customers that

1 will be subject to the discontinuance to provide an update for the projected date of the
2 discontinuance of service, subject to Commission approval. This will allow customers
3 more time to transition to a new service provider during this extended time. As previously
4 noted, there will be no interruption in service until a final order from the Commission
5 authorizing the discontinuance. At the time of the new notice, VES will also provide the
6 Commission with an updated filing identifying the new date and requesting that the matter
7 be processed toward a final Order from the Commission authorizing the discontinuance.
