Summary

On May 29, 2009, Verizon California, Inc., Verizon Long Distance, LLC, VerizonEnterprises Solutions, Frontier Communications Corporation, New Communications of the Southwest, Inc., and New Communications Online and Long Distance, Inc. ("Applicants"), filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a joint application for approval of the transfer of Verizon Communications, Inc.'s local exchange and long distance services, provided in Arizona by Verizon California, Inc., to Applicants to be owned and controlled by Frontier Communications Corporation. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has not yet made a recommendation regarding the Applicants' application, and the Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Applicants, Staff, or any intervenors. The Commission will issue a decision regarding the Applicants' application following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing.

About Intervention

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. **If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than October 1, 2009.** You must send copies of the motion to the Applicants or its counsel, and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number, and the name, address, and telephone number of any party upon whom documents are to be served in your place, if desired;
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Applicants, a shareholder of the Applicants, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of your motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicants or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that **all motions to intervene must be filed on or before October 1, 2009.** If representation by counsel is required by Rule 3 1 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. For information about requesting intervention, visit the Arizona Corporation Commission's webpage at <http://www.azcc.gov/divisions/utilities/forms.asp>. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. **However, failure to intervene will not preclude any customer from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on such customer's own behalf.**
