**SECOND**  
**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(RESCHEDULES PRE-HEARING**  
**CONFERENCE)**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 7, 2009, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Michael C. Reynolds and Tanzia Reynolds, husband and wife, Cash 2 U, LLC ("C2U"), Dos Ninas, LLC ("2NL"), and Par 3 Management, LLC ("Par 3") (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of promissory notes and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On August 13, 2009, a request for hearing was filed by Respondent, Tanzia Reynolds.

On August 18, 2009, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on September 15, 2009.

On September 10, 2009, Tanzia Reynolds filed a request for a 60-day continuance of the pre-hearing conference stating that she requires additional time to retain counsel.

1 On September 11, 2009, the Division filed its response to Ms. Reynolds' request. The  
2 Division objects to a 60-day continuance, but indicates that it does not object to a 30-day continuance  
3 pointing out that Ms. Reynolds has had notice of this proceeding since the beginning of August.

4 Under the circumstances, it appears that Ms. Reynolds has had ample notice of the  
5 proceeding, but she should be afforded reasonable time to secure counsel.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **the pre-hearing conference scheduled on**  
7 **September 15, 2009 shall be vacated.**

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **the pre-hearing conference shall be rescheduled and**  
9 **shall be held on October 15, 2009, at 9:30 a.m.,** at the Commission's offices, 1200 West  
10 Washington Street, **Room 100,** Phoenix, Arizona.


