2 and, in support thereof, state as follows:

3 1. ASBA is a non-partisan, non-profit organization governed by its members.  
4 More than 240 public school governing boards are members are members of the Arizona  
5 School Boards Association. Its members represent more than 1,200 school board  
6 members and over 1.12 million Arizona children. ASBA members have a vital interest in  
7 energy issues and costs. Arizona’s public schools are significant consumers of electric  
8 energy and energy services and will be significantly affected by the Commission’s  
9 decision in this proceeding.

11 2. AASBO is a non-profit professional association providing support and  
12 professional development opportunities for individuals whose primary responsibility is  
13 the business management of a school district. Among its functions is to promote  
14 effectiveness and efficiency in school business methods and practices including the  
15 procurement of Arizona’s public schools energy needs.

17 3. Intervention by ASBA/AASBO will not unduly broaden the issues or delay
