PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On June 8, 2009, Columbus Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Columbus" or "Cooperative") filed the above-captioned rate application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission").

By Procedural Order dated August 24, 2009, the matter was set for hearing and a procedural schedule established.

On September 14, 2009, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Motion for Revised Pre-Filed Testimony Filing Due Dates. In its Motion Staff reports scheduling conflicts that necessitate modifying the pre-hearing filing deadlines in this matter, and that the Cooperative does not object to Staff's proposed modifications.

Under the circumstances, Staff's request is reasonable and Staff's proposed modified filing deadlines should be adopted as set forth herein below. The hearing date is not affected by the modified schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **the Staff Report** and/or any direct testimony and associated exhibits to be presented at hearing on behalf of Staff shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **January 14, 2010**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **direct testimony** and associated exhibits to be presented at hearing on behalf of intervenors shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **January 14, 2010**.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **response to the Staff Report** or rebuttal testimony and  
2 associated exhibits to be presented at hearing by the Company shall be reduced to writing and filed  
3 on or before **February 3, 2010**.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **surrebuttal testimony** and associated exhibits to be  
5 presented by the Staff and/or intervenors shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before **February**  
6 **16, 2010**.


7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **rejoinder testimony** and associated exhibits shall be  
8 presented in oral testimony at the hearing on **February 24, 2010**.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of the August 24, 2009 Procedural  
10 Order shall remain in effect.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended  
12 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (3) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
14 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


