1 **Q. Finally, what are Staff's recommendations?**

2 A. Staff recommends:

- 3 - that the Commission transfer the local exchange services CC&N to NewILEC;
- 4 - that the Commission approve the transfer of long distance customers from VLD and
- 5 VES to NewLD within the local exchange service areas of VCA, grant a waiver of
- 6 the Commission's Slamming Rules⁵⁶ in connection with the transfer, and grant a
- 7 Long Distance Reseller CC&N to NewLD;
- 8 - that the Commission allow NewILEC to adopt the tariffs of VCA and allow
- 9 NewILD to adopt the tariffs of VLD and VES;
- 10 - that the Commission designate NewILEC in the service areas proposed for transfer
- 11 as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") with the same status as VCA;
- 12 - that the Commission approve the transfer of assets pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-285 and
- 13 take such other measures and provide any additional approvals as the Commission
- 14 may deem necessary to allow the parties to complete the transaction;
