PROCEDURAL ORDER
GRANTING ADMISSION
PRO HAC VICE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 3, 2009, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Laura M. Kam, an attorney with DLA Piper LLP, filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Motion and Consent of Local Counsel for Temporary *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Peter H. Bresnan in the above-captioned matter, on behalf of the Respondent, JPMorgan Chase & Co.

On September 8, 2009, by Procedural Order, the request for temporary admission *pro hac vice* of Peter H. Bresnan to appear before the Commission was granted, provided that the completion of the application procedures occurs within 45 days of the Procedural Order.
