I have to make a correction to the email I sent you on Sept. 20th. The two petitions I said were the same petitions were actually two different petitions. The petition hand delivered by Ms. Winklemann had 800 signatures by residents that were here in Gold Canyon. The petition mailed by Mr. Kelly were signatures from people who had gone back to their home states and had sent the information back to Gold Canyon so that it also could be counted.

It is interesting to note that all the information gathered on these two petitions contradict the information given to the Commission about the daily use for one day in February. Each person who signed the petition listed the water usage for that February in 2005 shown on their water bill. The average daily usage for all these people was 145 gallons per day. That totals to only 870,000 gallons for any day in February, 2005 for the approximate 6,000 customers the sewer company had at that time. That is quite different from the 1.2 million gallons Gold Canyon Sewer Company claimed to have processed.

Gold Canyon Sewer Company has not been totally honest with the information given to the commission. They pick and chose what they want you to know, and sometimes it seems that they also give false information.

By the way, we still have odors coming from the facility even though the sewer company claims they have corrected the problem.

Fred may I make technical correction to your letter to Kristin Mayes?; the petitions hand delivered to that office second floor by Mrs. Dolly Winkelmann (480-982-6668) were PETITIONS (plural) about 800 signed names, addresses and phone numbers, stating their daily consumption. (20 names per page)

The petitions mailed by me at the Apache Junction Post-office were approximately 200 names with the same information, but were sent to me and Mrs. Pat Prince of Gold Canyon Community who were back in their home states and sending their information to me and Pat. These were printed out by me and I also did the calculations on all petitioners. The results were; average for all signers, 145 gallons per day (as reported to all customers of Arizona Water Company for daily water consumption). The same results were calculated for the mail delivered petitions 145 gallons per day.

At that period of time total customers of the water company was approximately 6000.

The petition results proved my contention; there was no honesty to the Gold Canyon Sewer Company's claim to have received 1.2 million gallons on one day February 2005.
