In the matter of the aforementioned docket numbers, 1, the undersigned, a resident of Maricopa, Arizona, located in Pinal County, do hereby oppose the proposed increases from Global Water for the following reasons:

- Increased utility cast at the requested level, not only effects my personal financial budget but the Homeowners Association that I live in will be plated in a worse financial condition than it is already in due to delinquencies and foreclosures.
- The proposed rate increases are solely to provide a higher rate of return for the investors and no improvements to service, quality of water or distribution ability is planned.
- Maricopa is one of the hardest hit areas in the country with foreclosures. Any of these proposed increases will be detrimental to attracting builders and/or buyers which will further stigmatize our real estate values and the desirability of this area.
