FOURTH
PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 15, 1996, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order to Cease and Desist, for Restitution and Administrative Penalties ("Notice"). Therein, the Division alleged that the above-captioned Respondents had committed violations of the Arizona Securities Act.

On December 5, 1996, Interactive Technologies West, Inc. ("ITW") and Mr. Louis F. Conant, III filed a request for a hearing in response to the Notice. Therein, these Respondents requested that a scheduling conference take place to set the date of hearing.

On December 10, 1996, the Commission, by Procedural Order, scheduled a procedural hearing on the Notice.

On December 17, 1996, Mr. Kyle E. Gillman filed a request for a hearing in response to the Notice. Therein, counsel for Mr. Gillman indicated that he would attend the scheduled proceeding.

On December 23, 1996, the hearing was convened at the Commission's offices in Phoenix, Arizona. ITW and Mr. Conant appeared with counsel. Mr. Gillman's counsel entered an appearance on his behalf. The Division was also present and represented by counsel. The conduct of the above-

1 captioned proceeding was discussed and it was pointed out that there is a parallel criminal investigation
2 which is pending that involves the above-named Respondents. Due to this factor, counsel for the
3 respective parties and the Division indicated that they would be filing a Stipulated Agreement
4 ("Agreement") regarding the further conduct of the administrative proceeding. The hearing was recessed
5 pending the filing of the Agreement.

6 On February 20, 1997, the Division, ITW and Messrs. Conant and Gillman filed the Agreement
7 and a pre-hearing conference was scheduled for June 3, 1997.

8 Subsequently, due to scheduling conflicts the June 3, 1997, pre-hearing conference was continued
9 to September 10, 1997

10 The criminal investigation is still ongoing, and the Division and the respective Respondents have
11 agreed that the proceeding should be continued indefinitely during this investigation.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the above-captioned proceeding shall be continued until
13 further Order.
