Attached is an application by Why Utility Co., Inc. for the transfer of all Assets and is hereby applying for formal approval of the Arizona Corporation Commission of the transfer.

The Transferee will be Why Domestic Water Improvement District which was established by the Pima County Board of Supervisors on July 14, 2009 by resolution #152. The majority of the Why Utility Company members approved the transfer by petition prior to the filing for a Water District. The sole purpose of the WDWID is to acquire the assets and facilities of the Why Utility Company, and provide ongoing management to supply the Community of Why, Arizona, with domestic water service and campground facilities for Rvers.

The Why Utility Co. was incorporated in 1968. It has been managed by a Board of Directors elected by the Membership on the First Monday of February each year serving (without compensation) one year or more if reelected.

It is in the best interest of the community to own and operate its water system and two (2) RV Parks, assuring continued proper maintenance of the physical system, maintenance of the water contracts, wells, filtration system and lowest possible water rates.

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CONSENT TO ASSIGNMENT OF PIMA COUNTY PUBLIC UTILITY LICENSE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona, granted to Why Utility Company, Inc., an Arizona corporation ("Licensee"), that certain Pima County Public Utility License Agreement (the "License"), recorded April 10, 2008, in Docket 13282, at Page 1520, in the Office of the County Recorder of Pima County, Arizona; and

WHEREAS, Section 23 of the License provides for the transfer and assignment of the License by Licensee, with the prior written consent of the Pima County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved the organization and establishment of the Why Domestic Water Improvement District of Pima County, Arizona (the "District") by that certain Resolution and Order Establishing the Why Domestic Water Improvement District of Pima County, Arizona, recorded July 14, 2009, in Docket 13599, at Page 3081; and

WHEREAS, the District will supersede and be the successor in interest to the Licensee and would like all pertinent County records to reflect the name change of the Licensee to that of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Pima County Board of Supervisors has no objection to the transfer of the License to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 23 of the License, the Pima County Board of Supervisors does hereby consent to the assignment of the License to the Why Domestic Water Improvement District of Pima County, Arizona, subject to all of the terms and conditions of the License, as recorded.
2. Why Domestic Water Improvement District of Pima County, Arizona hereby assumes all obligations and liabilities under the License, and shall be bound by all the terms and conditions thereof, effective upon execution of this Consent by the Pima County Board of Supervisors.
