14 On June 15, 2009, Karen Schaefer ("Complainant") filed with the Arizona Corporation
15 Commission ("Commission") a Complaint ("Complaint") against N.D. Bales d/b/a Sunizona Water
16 Company ("Respondent").

17 On June 24, 2009, the Respondent filed its Response to the Complaint.


1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file their witness list and exhibits to be


