Dear Representatives:

The homeowners at 35th Avenue and Dynamite are deeply concerned about the power line that APS is going to put in behind our houses on the west side of I-17 and Dynamite homes. We purchased these lots that are adjacent to the desert for a premium for a reason. We enjoy the quietness and the view that I get from my back yard. I can look out over my fence and view a beautiful desert. Everyday I see rabbits, doves, quail and coyotes run through the area.

Now I am told that a power line with 60 foot metal poles and 6 powers lines will run 15 feet from our back fence. I did not pay a premium of \$30,000 to look at power lines in my back view. This also will negatively affect our home values.

We know there is an alternative to bury these lines for approximately 600 feet, but APS has been unwilling to do this. The area where the lines are to be buried is nothing but desert with small shrubs. It seems it would be easy enough to bury these and make everyone happy.

Our homes have dropped 50% because of the foreclosures, we do not need another drop because our aesthetic value is gone.

Construction is to begin in 2 weeks. (October 29) We were only give a 2 week notice and they put a 2 week

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hold on construction.

Your help with this would be very appreciated.
