PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On September 26, 2006, IEelement Telephone of Arizona, Inc., ("IEelement" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services and facilities-based long distance telecommunications services in Arizona.

On October 5, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Insufficiency and its First Set of Data Requests in this matter.

On November 2, 2006, IEelement filed its response to Staff's Data Requests.

On November 9, 2006, Staff filed a second Letter of Insufficiency and a Second Set of Data Requests.

On November 22, 2006, IEelement filed its response to Staff's Second Set of Data Requests.

On June 6, 2007, Staff filed its Staff Report recommending approval of IEelement's application.

On June 27, 2007, by Procedural Order, the hearing in this matter was scheduled for August 15, 2007. The Procedural Order also instructed IEelement to publish notice of the hearing by July 13, 2007, and to file an Affidavit of Publication by July 31, 2007.

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1 On July 16, 2007, IElement filed a Request for Continuance (“Request”) stating that it was  
2 unable to meet the specified publication date and requesting that the Commission grant it additional  
3 time to publish notice of the hearing.

4 On August 3, 2007, by Procedural Order, the hearing in this matter was continued to  
5 September 27, 2007.

6 On August 24, 2007, IElement filed a Request for Continance of the September 27, 2007  
7 hearing. IElement’s Request stated that its parent company was engaged in negotiations with another  
8 entity and that a possible merger was anticipated. IElement’s Request sought an additional 30-day  
9 continuance so that the merger discussions could be completed.

10 On August 28, 2007, by Procedural Order, the Company’s request for a continuance of the  
11 hearing date was granted. The Procedural Order also advised that no further hearing dates would be  
12 set until IElement filed a request with the Commission to reset the hearing. The timeclock was  
13 suspended indefinitely.

14 There have been no additional filings in the matter, and on August 18, 2009, a Procedural  
15 Order was issued in which Staff was ordered to update the Commission on the status of this  
16 IElement’s application with any appropriate recommendations, not later than September 30, 2009.

17 On September 15, 2009, IElement filed a request to withdraw its application and that no  
18 further action should be taken in this docket.

19 On September 30, 2009, Staff filed an update stating that Staff does not object to IElement’s  
20 request to withdraw its application, and that Staff recommends that this docket be administratively  
21 closed.

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
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1 Accordingly, IElement's request to withdraw the application in this docket should be granted,  
2 and this docket should be administratively closed.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that IElement's request to withdraw its application in this  
4 matter is hereby granted.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Docket No. T-20481A-06-0617 shall be administratively  
6 closed.
