RE: IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF TELALEASING ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR APPROVAL TO CANCEL THEIR CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR CUSTOMER OWNED PAY TELEPHONE SERVICES (DOCKET NO. T-03192A-09-0423)

On September 3, 2009, Telaleasing Enterprises, Inc. ("Telaleasing" or "Applicant") filed an Application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide Customer Owned Pay Telephone ("COPT") service. The Commission granted Telaleasing a CC&N to provide COPT service in Decision No. 59888, dated November 26, 1996.

Telaleasing stated in its application that COPT service is no longer provided in the state of Arizona. Further, the Applicant states in its 2007 Annual Report that its payphones were sold on September 7, 2007. The Applicant has waived its right to a hearing and to receive notice of the hearing date in order to cancel the CC&N.

Consumer Services reports that no complaints, inquiries, or opinions were filed against Telaleasing from January 1, 2006 through September 18, 2009.

The Applicant is not in Good Standing with the Corporations Section of the Arizona Corporation Commission. The Annual Report due May 17, 2009 has not been filed.

Staff recommends approval of Telaleasing's application to cancel its COPT CC&N. Upon cancellation of its CC&N, Telaleasing will no longer be authorized to provide COPT telecommunications services in the state of Arizona and will no longer be subject to the requirements of Decision No. 59888.
