PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 18, 1999, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing Regarding Proposed Order for Relief ("Notice") against Mr. James Troy Bredeson, Mr. Ronald John Hoover, Mr. Lowell Robert Taylor a/k/a Jim Taylor and Mr. Patrick Robin Hogue in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of evidences of indebtedness and investment contracts.

Mr. Taylor was duly served with copies of the Notice.

On May 27, 1999, counsel for Mr. Taylor filed a timely request for hearing. No other requests for hearing were filed.

On June 21, 1999, a pre-hearing conference was held, and counsel for Mr. Taylor and the Division stipulated to a hearing being scheduled for August 26, 1999, at 9:30 a.m. at the

1 Commission's offices in Phoenix, Arizona unless a settlement was reached prior to the hearing date.

2 On August 13, 1999, counsel for Mr. Taylor withdraw from the proceeding.

3 On August 24, 1999, the Division requested a continuance of the proceeding until on or after
4 October 5, 1999 because, although a settlement had been negotiated, Mr. Taylor wished to review its
5 terms with another attorney, who would be unavailable because he would be out of Arizona for most
6 of the month of September.

7 On August 25, 1999, by Procedural Order, the proceeding was continued to October 7, 1999.

8 On October 6, 1999, the Division filed a Motion to Vacate the hearing date pending the
9 Commission's approval of a Consent Order.

10 Accordingly, the hearing should be vacated.

11 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for October 7, 1999, at 9:30 a.m.,
12 shall be vacated.


