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On September 8, 2009, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision No. 71272 (“Decision”) in the above-captioned matter. The Decision contains a requirement that within 60 days of the date of the Decision (November 9, 2009), Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. (“SSVEC” or “Cooperative”) file revised line extension policies “which reflect Schedule of Charges, a statement that quotes provided to customers will be itemized, and procedures for refunding amounts to customers when additional customers connect to the line extension.”¹

Although SSVEC has been diligently working on revised line extension policies to file in conformance with the Decision, SSVEC has not yet completed such policies in order to file them with the Commission by November 9, 2009. SSVEC is a small rural electric cooperative with limited staff and resources. SSVEC is currently actively involved in multiple Commission dockets, including the following active dockets:

SSVEC hereby requests a two (2) week extension to file the revised line extension policies until November 23, 2009, and requests the Commission’s Hearing Division schedule an expedited procedural conference to address this request on or before the November 9, 2009, compliance deadline. SSVEC submits that this brief extension of the compliance deadline as requested herein is in the public interest. It will provide the Cooperative the additional time necessary for SSVEC to complete and file its revised line extension policies.

SSVEC respectfully requests that the Commission approve the request set forth herein. There are currently no parties in this docket other than the Cooperative and Staff. Counsel for SSVEC will be at the Commission on November 9, 2009, attending the SolarCity proceeding and can be available any time at the convenience of the Administrative Law Judge and Staff.
