Mr. Newman:

I am a resident of SaddleBrooke and southern Pinal County. I installed solar PV panels last month at considerable cost.

I just received my first billing from Trico, and although I am producing more electricity than I am consuming, Trico is charging me for the power that I purchase from them during the non sunny hours. Trico promises that they will reimburse me for my overproduction in the first quarter of 2010.

The problem is that they are charging me approximately 14-cents per Kwh, and reimbursing me at three-cents per Kwh. This disparity hardly reinforces my decision to "go solar."

Trico assures me that fairness is just around the corner -- as soon as the ACC approves their proposal for "net metering." This proposal was submitted to you on September 30th.

My plea to you is to please expedite your review and approve Trico's proposal. Each day that you delay is costing me money.

You have had the proposal now for five-weeks. Getting "net metering" approved in the next five-days would be nice!
