It has just been brought to my attention that a recent vote by you all cancelled plans for the installation of a new electrical transmission line to the Sonoita, Patagonia and Elgin area. Because of this it appears as the SSVEC has filed an application for a moratorium on all future power hook ups in this area.

As a land owner in Sonoita, and someone who planned on building a retirement home in the next few years on my property, I find the extremely disturbing. I purchased the property I owned, which has utilities currently run to it, with the knowledge that I would be able to get a power hook up at anytime.

Many people's current and future lively hoods depend on the provision of a reliable source of electricity and for a vocal few minority to put this in peril is despicable.

I strongly urge you to reconsider your stance on this issue and re-vote in favor of allowing the installation of the new electrical power line.
