PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On March 22, 2002, the Hearing Division of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") convened a Procedural Conference for the purpose of discussing scheduling issues relating to the CAP Gemini Ernst & Young ("CGE&Y") Final Report on the OSS test. At that time the parties proposed the following schedule:

For OSS Test:

- March 29, 2002                      Release of complete Final Report and any other test reports and underlying documentation to be available for all reports for viewing at CGE&Y facilities
- April 8, 2002                        Staff Report on CGE&Y Final Report and any other reports that were issued on March 29
- April 10, 2002                      Questions from any participants are due to CGE&Y and HP about Final Report and any other reports
- April 12, 2002                      Questions from any participants due on Staff Report.
- April 15-17, 2002                  Responses to questions posed by participants due from CGE&Y and HP
- April 17-19, 2002                  Workshop to address Final Report and any other test reports issued on March 29
- April 22, 2002                      Staff amendments ("redlined"), if any, to its report due

1 April 26, 2002 Comments due from participants on CGE&Y Final Report and  
2 Staff Report

3 For CMP issues:

4 April 8, 2002 Briefs filed by participants responding to Qwest 3/15 CMP  
5 Status Report and addressing any impasse issues

6 April 19, 2002 Staff issues a report resolving any impasse issues

7 April 26, 2002 Comments due from participants on Staff's Report

8 The parties agreed that if Qwest fails the DUF test or there are any impasse issues on SATE  
9 evaluation, independent reports will be issued and separate schedules established to address those  
10 reports.<sup>1</sup>

11 The consensus schedule is reasonable and should be adopted.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the above schedule for the OSS test and CMP evaluation  
13 should be adopted.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any other procedural safeguards set in previous Procedural  
15 Orders shall remain in effect, including, but not limited to, extending the deadlines if underlying  
16 documentation is not available for review.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if Qwest fails the DUF test or there are any impasse issues  
18 on SATE evaluation, independent reports will be issued and the Hearing Division will establish  
19 separate schedules to address those reports.
