**STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSTION OF
TIME RE: RATE DESIGN SURREBUTTAL
TESTIMONY**

12 The Utilities Division of Arizona Corporation Commission ("Staff") hereby requests
13 additional time to file the surrebuttal testimony for Staff relating to rate design until December 8,
14 2009. Pursuant to the May 28, 2009 procedural order issued by the Administrative Law Judge, Staff
15 is currently required to file all surrebuttal testimony and associated exhibits on or before December 7,
16 2009.

17 Staff needs this additional day to complete its analysis relating to rate design. Staff does not
18 believe this request is overly burdensome to the Company or the other parties. Staff is only seeking
19 this additional time for the surrebuttal testimony regarding rate design. All other Staff surrebuttal
20 testimony will be filed on December 7, 2009. In order to accommodate this extension, Staff proposes
21 the following changes to the May 28, 2009 procedural order:



25 In addition, the parties are currently required to bring an issues matrix to the prehearing
26 conference currently scheduled for December 10, 2009. While all issues should be solidified by that
27 date, Staff requests that the parties be able to bring their issues matrices to the hearing on December
28 14, 2009 instead of to the prehearing conference.

1 Staff has conferred with counsel for the Company, the Residential Utility Consumer Office,
2 and The Water Utility Association of Arizona, and they do not object to this procedural modification
3 relating to rate design testimony. This modification to the procedural schedule will not delay the
4 hearing currently set to begin on December 14, 2009.

5 Wherefore Staff respectfully requests this modification to the procedural order regarding rate
6 design testimony, with all other procedural order dates to remain the same.
