PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Our Procedural Order dated March 29, 2002, set the following schedule for the consideration of the CAP Gemini Ernst & Young ("CGE&Y") Final Report and Staff Report on the OSS test¹:

- March 29, 2002 Release of complete Final Report and any other test reports and underlying documentation to be available for all reports for viewing at CGE&Y facilities
- April 8, 2002 Staff Report on CGE&Y Final Report and any other reports that were issued on March 29
- April 10, 2002 Questions from any participants are due to CGE&Y and HP about Final Report and any other reports
- April 12, 2002 Questions from any participants due on Staff Report.
- April 15-17, 2002 Responses to questions posed by participants due from CGE&Y and HP
- April 17-19, 2002 Workshop to address Final Report and any other test reports issued on March 29
- April 22, 2002 Staff amendments ("redlined"), if any, to its report due
- April 26, 2002 Comments due from participants on CGE&Y Final Report and Staff Report

¹ The due dates for the Staff Report and Comments on the Staff Report were extended to April 10, 2002 and April 15, 2002, respectively, by Procedural Order dated April 4, 2002.

1 On April 8, 2002, Commission Staff filed a Motion for Modification of the Procedural
 2 Schedule. Staff requests that the date for submission of the Staff Report be extended to April 23,
 3 2002, and the date for parties to comment on the Staff recommendation be extended to May 3, 2002.
 4 Staff reports that despite its diligent work, it will not been able to meet the May 10, 2002 due date for
 5 the report because of competing commitments in Qwest's Wholesale Pricing Docket and other cases.
 6 Staff notes that its request to extend the deadline for the Staff Report will eliminate the potential need
 7 to file an amended report after the workshop and for the parties to submit questions on the Staff
 8 Report prior to the workshop.

9 Qwest filed an Opposition to Staff's Motion on April 10, 2002. Qwest objected to extending
 10 the deadline because Staff would not agree to committing to issue a Staff Report on Section 272 on
 11 April 15, 2002 and a Staff Report on Public Interest (including Track A) on April 22, 2002. Qwest
 12 argues the workshops on 272 and Public Interest were held last summer and these reports should have
 13 issued long ago. Qwest asserts there is no need to delay the issuance of the Staff Report on Public
 14 Interest until after the scheduled Public Comment meetings.

15 AT&T and WorldCom do not oppose the Motion.

16 In its Motion, Staff stated it would try to issue the 272 Report on April 16, 2002. Staff's
 17 request for an extension ultimately only results in a one week delay. Under the circumstances,
 18 including the concurrent scheduling of the Wholesale Price Docket, Staff's request is reasonable.

19 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the schedule set in our March 29, 2002 Procedural
 20 Order, as modified in our April 4, 2002 Procedural Order, shall be modified as follows:

April 10, 2002	Questions from any participants are due to CGE&Y and HP about Final Report and any other reports issued on March 29, 2002
April 15-17, 2002	Responses to questions posed by participants due from CGE&Y and HP
April 17-19, 2002	Workshop to address Final Report and any other test reports issued on March 29

1 April 23, 2002 Staff Report on CGE&Y Final Report and any other reports that
2 were issued on March 29

3 May 3, 2002 Comments due from participants on CGE&Y Final Report and
4 Staff Report

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any other procedural safeguards set in previous Procedural
6 Orders shall remain in effect.


